Applicants must print out a copy of their submitted application and bring it to their appointment.

##### **TRANSFER STUDENTS**

- Copy of the submitted application
- College/University transcript
- 1 letter of recommendation
- Personal essay (can be the one from the common application)
- High school transcript (only if completed less than 30 college credits)
- SAT or ACT test scores (only if completed less than 30 college credits)
- TOEFL or IELTS scores (only if completed less than 30 college credits)

## **Requirements for Appointment**

### HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

- Minimum of 2.8 GPA (4.0 scale)
- Minimum SAT score of 900 (old test) or 980 (new test), or ACT composite score of 19
- Minimum TOEFL score of 70 or IELTS score of 6.0 (if required)

### TRANSFER STUDENTS

- Minimum of 2.3 college GPA
- Minimum TOEFL score of 70 or IELTS score of 6.0 (if required)

- ☐ Minimum 2.7 GPA (on 4.0 scale)
- ☐ English language requirement for direct admission: SAT ERW 480+, TOEFL 79+, IELTS overall band 6.0+, PTE 53+ or qualifying English language courses and grades in high school
- ☐ For Nursing: SAT minimum 1100 (new SAT) or 1020 (old SAT) or ACT 22
- ☐ For Computer Science and Engineering programs: 3 units of a laboratory science including Physics and Chemistry and 4 units of college prep math, including precalculus. Calculus is strongly recommended.

### Requirements for Appointment (Transfer)

- ☐ Minimum 2.0 GPA (on 4.0 scale)
- ☐ English language requirement for direct admission: SAT ERW 480+, TOEFL 79+, IELTS overall band 6.0+, PTE 53+ or qualifying English Composition course.

## **Felician University** **International Instant Decision Day Requirements**

### **Application**

Any student who signs up for an appointment with Felician University is not required to have already applied to the university. If the student has applied, the applicant must print out a copy of that application and bring it with them to the appointment. If the applicant has not applied, a paper application will be provided at the appointment.

### **Documentation Needed at Appointment**

- Application (if already applied)
- High school or post-secondary school transcript
- TOEFL or IELTS scores (unless attended high school or community college in U.S. for a minimum of one-full year)
- A personal statement
- SAT (suggested but not required)
- Letters of recommendation (minimum one, maximum three)
- Copy of passport information page

### **Requirements for appointment**

- Minimum of 2.0 GPA (4.0 scale)
- Minimum TOEFL score of 65 iBT or IELTS score of 6.0 (if applicable)
- 700 or higher on the Math and Critical Reading scores on the SAT (if applicable).

### **Nursing applicant requirements for appointment**

- Official Transcripts
- 3.0 or higher GPA required
- 900 or higher on the Math and Critical Reading scores on the SAT
- A grade of B- or higher in high school laboratory biology and chemistry
- A grade of B- in two years of university preparatory mathematics, including at least one year of algebra.

## Instant Decision Day Application Requirements

Prospective students can complete an online application by clicking 'Apply Now' on [www.mercy.edu](http://www.mercy.edu). A guide to the International Application Process can be found on our International Admissions website: <https://www.mercy.edu/admissions/international>.

The application fee of \$45.00 will be waived.

The application should be submitted online before the Instant Decision event. If completing the hard copy application, the student should present this on the day of the event, and the fee can be waived then also.

There will be a limited amount of hard copies of the application available to complete on the day of the event.

### **Documentation needed at appointment:**

1. **Application** (preferably completed beforehand online)
2. **Official Academic Transcripts and Foreign Academic Credential Evaluation for any foreign transcripts; evaluation of foreign transcripts are accepted from NACES, AICE or AACRAO members.** *'Official' means that the transcript is sealed in an envelope from the institution, and that there are no classes in progress on the transcript (all classes have been completed).* *Otherwise, a conditional acceptance decision may be offered.*
  - The minimum GPA accepted is 2.0, although this may differ for certain specialty programs.
3. **Official Proof of English Language Proficiency • 71 TOEFL or 6.0 IELTS for Undergraduate, and 80 TOEFL or 6.5 IELTS for Graduate.** *'Official' means the scores are presented in a sealed envelope from the testing center. \*\*In certain cases, a waiver can be granted, if the student has official, acceptable documentation to prove that they have the sufficient English language level.*

**For High school students: Academic High School Transcript Evaluations must be course by course evaluations.**

**For Transfer students: Academic High School Transcript Evaluations can be general, and the University Transcript Evaluations must be course by course evaluations.**

Instant decisions are not available for the following majors/programs: Art, Education, Music, Seven-year Medical Program, Seven-year Optometry Program. TCNJ's Center for American Language & Culture offers intensive credit-bearing study of English (ESL) and the university provides both Regular and Conditional (ESL) Admission. ### Guidelines for Undergraduate **HIGH SCHOOL** Applicants at International Instant Decision Day

#### Requirements for Appointment Eligibility

- Minimum high school GPA of 3.0 (4.0 scale)
- Full load of academic classes, typically 16 high school units

#### Documentation that Eligible Applicants Must Bring to the Instant Decision Day Appointment

- Printed copy of previously submitted Common Application including essay
- All high school transcripts (international coursework should be translated into U.S. credits using a NACES.org-approved agency)
- TOEFL or IELTS scores
- SAT or ACT scores
- 2 letters of recommendation (high school teachers)

### Guidelines for Undergraduate **UNIVERSITY TRANSFER** Applicants at International Instant Decision Day

#### Requirements for Appointment Eligibility

- Minimum university GPA of 2.5 (4.0 scale)
- Earned or be in the process of earning at least 12 university credits

#### Documentation that Eligible Applicants Must Bring to the Instant Decision Day Appointment

- Printed copy of previously submitted Common Application including essay
- All high school transcripts (international coursework should be translated into U.S. credits using a NACES.org-approved agency)
- All university transcripts (international coursework should be translated into U.S. credits using a NACES.org-approved agency)
- College Report reflecting current university status (available in Common Application)
- TOEFL or IELTS scores
- SAT or ACT scores
- 2 letters of recommendation (university instructors)

- One Standard Test Score: SAT, ACT, TOEFL, IELTS or PTE score
  - ❖ If a **university transfer applicant** has successfully completed English composition at a U.S.-accredited college or university, no standard test score is needed.
- Essay (can be the one from the common application)
- One letter of recommendation

- Minimum high school GPA 2.6 (4.0 scale)

### Requirements for Appointment (for undergraduate UNIVERSITY TRANSFER applicants)

## **William Paterson University** **International Instant Decision Day Requirements**

Any student who signs up for an appointment with William Paterson University is required to have already applied online via the Common Application or our own online application.

**No performing arts or fine art applications at Instant Decision Day.**

### **Requirements for appointment**

- Minimum of 3.0 GPA (4.0 scale)
- Minimum TOEFL score of 79 or IELTS score of 6.0
- Minimum of 16 college-preparatory units
  - 4 units – English
  - 2 units – Laboratory Science
  - 3 units – College Prep Mathematics (Algebra I and II, Geometry)
  - 2 units - Social Studies
  - 5 units – Additional work in at least two of the following: History, Languages (minimum 2 units in one language), Mathematics, Science or English.

### **Major-specific applicant requirements for appointment**

- Nursing 1130 new, 3.0 GPA, 23 ACT, B and above in Biology and Chemistry
- Communication Disorders 1090 new, 3.0 GPA, 22 ACT
- SAT/ACTs are required for Nursing, Communication Disorders, and merit-based scholarship consideration.
